



Classic Display on 29th July 2012

Dear Classic Vehicle Enthusiast

Thank-you for downloading the manual registration form for the 2012 Worstead Festival classic vehicle display. Your registration can be completed by sending the completed form overleaf with 2 stamped-addressed envelopes and a postal registration fee of £5 (made payable to Worstead Festival) to the address shown at the foot of the form. We are really looking forward to the second classic vehicle display at the 2012 Worstead Festival.

The festival preparations are moving forward and we have retained many aspects of the new festival from last year. We have more attractions for kids and adults alike, games and competitions, crafts and stalls, music on a central stage, a beer festival, a good food area with presentations from top local chefs, a medieval encampment, the starting handle club and of course, a display ring. For the classic vehicle display, we have the same area as last year – the area of paddock on Mill Hill adjacent to the main festival field. The entrance for vehicles will be close to the display area and via the field entrance at the junction of Norwich Road and Station Road. I hope to improve the entrance arrangements this year to speed access.

As a result of the feedback from last year I hope to make improvements in the facilities at the classic vehicle site. Most exhibitors gave us a great report after last year's event but there were a few complaints. We will be improving toilet facilities and adding an area with tables and seating (and some shade – which I hope we'll need). I am also hoping to have a small tractor/bus trailer service running as a shuttle service between the classic site and the main festival field as I know from my own experience that walking across the rough pasture is not easy. We have plenty of space and clubs will be parked together if they wish.

We would ask you to be on the site by 10.30 am and stay until at least 4.30pm - so we have a good display for our visitors. Passes will be issued by the gate staff upon arrival (subsequent to vehicles meeting the requirements for display - built in 1982 or before and fully road legal). Your pre-registered registration number and vehicle details will be available to the gate staff on the day, to make your passes available. I hope you'll all stay longer than 4.30 though - we're sure you will enjoy the new festival!

There will be a judged competition and trophies awarded for vehicles in the following categories; veteran, classic, retro, motorcycle and the humdinger - best overall vehicle. I am confident we will reach my target of 100 plus classic cars and motorcycles - with some 50 entrants registered to date. The organisers do retain the right to refuse entry to vehicles which have not been or are unlikely to be prepared to the standard for a classic vehicle display.
